

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Fellow Members and Friends of the CBA,

2021 had been a challenging year for all of us with covid-19 at its height and uncertainty of what happens next. Whilst we are presently out of the Covid-19 mandate of mask wearing and socially distancing, we still need to be vigilant of our environment and be aware of what needs to be done for the safety and protection of our health and community.

Despite the intermittent changes in 2021 and 2022 resulting from the uncertainly of covid-19, CBA has been able to host some events such as the Canada Day event in 2021 and 2022. The heat on July 1, 2021, had caused us to reschedule the celebration of Canada Day from July 1 to July 10, 2021, and the July 1, 2022, event was quickly rescheduled from an outdoor to indoor event. It was interesting to observe how these two events were so quickly rescheduled within a period of two days. Our sincere thanks to the coordinators of these two events. CBA had also hosted other events involving TD Park, the youth members of both the Chinese Community and Indigenous Community. Finally, CBA coordinated the celebration of Lunar New Year 2022 in May instead of February. Such interesting times, the Chinese community needs to be recognized for their flexibility and readiness to manage change.

The tragedy on May 18, 2022, in Edmonton Chinatown, where two Chinatown business community members lost their lives due to the murderous action of a socially challenged individual, released to the Edmonton Chinatown location without much reflection on the danger posed to the neighborhood. As our community mourned the loss of these two members, we question the effectiveness of the justice system and the protection desperately required for the Chinatown Community.

Our Chinese Community must advocate for justice and protection from the three orders of government. For this action, CBA must solicit newer members with time and energy to enable the community to fulfill its mandate of seeking justice and protection and advocating for needs of the community.

Harbin Gate

The original Harbin Gate (102 Avenue) was removed as part of the Valley Line Southeast LRT project and placed in storage. After much discussion and consultation, the Chinese Community, Harbin and the City of Edmonton agreed that a new Chinatown Gate will be built and located at 97 Street and Jasper Avenue.

On behalf of the Directors of the CBA, I wish everyone a safe and fun filled summer and prosperity in the years to come.

主席心聲

親愛的中華會館會員和中華會館的朋友們

大家好! 2021 年對我們大家都是充滿挑戰的一年,Covid-19 疫情的嚴重性和不確定性,讓我們不知道將會面對什麼問題。雖然我們目前已沒有 Covid-19 的口罩佩戴限制令和社交距離要求,我們仍需要對環境保持警惕,並意識到需要採取哪些措施來保護我們的健康和社區。

儘管由於 covid-19 的不確定性,於 2021 年和 2022 年間歇性的發生了變化,中華會館仍然舉辦一些活動,例如 2021 年和 2022 年的加拿大日活動。2021 年 7 月 1 日的高溫導致我們將加拿大國慶日的慶祝時間從 2021 年 7 月 1 日改到了 7 月 10 日,而在 2022 年 7 月 1 日,該活動很快從室外活動改為室內活動,這是令人高興的是。這兩個事件是如何在兩天內如此迅速地重新安排,我們應該衷心感謝這兩場活動的組織者。

中華會館還主辦了另外其他活動,包活 TD PARK PEOPLE, 華人社區和土著社區的青年成員活動。最後,中華會館把 2022 年農曆新年的慶祝活動安排了 在 5 月,而不是 2 月。在這樣一個多變而有趣的時代,華人社區的靈活性和應變能力是得到值得認同。

2022年5月18日,在埃德蒙頓唐人街發生了倆宗悲劇,兩名唐人 街商業社區成員,因一名社會問題人士的謀殺行為,而失去了生命。這 悲劇發生在埃德蒙頓唐人街 ,是因為社會系統沒有對社區的危險性進 行太多的反思。當我們的社區哀悼這兩名成員的喪生時,我們質疑司法 系統的有效性以及唐人街社區安全和需要保護的迫切性。

我們的華人社區必須倡導正義,從三級政府中尋求幫助和保護。為此,對於這行動,中華會館必須徵集有時間和精力的新成員,使社區能夠履行其尋求正義和保護以及倡導社區需求的使命。

關於哈爾濱友誼門

原本的哈爾濱友誼門(位於 102 AVE)因為建設東南輕軌線的項目,已被移除。該門已經被保留。經華人社區,哈爾濱市政府和埃德蒙頓市政府的同意,建造一個新的唐人街大門。地點是已定於 97STREET和 JASPER AVE.

我謹代表中華會館的董事們,祝願大家在來年裡度過一個安全、充 滿樂趣的夏天,同時祝福大家在未來的日子里,家庭幸福,身心安泰!
